The Abington Police Athletic/Activities League is providing the "Valerie O. Applications along with (2) letters of recommendation (One teacher, Community member and PAL Center staff or volunteer) must be submitted to the PAL Director of Youth Programs. The Director will meet with PAL staff and volunteers to discuss all applications. The Activities Committee will review applications submitted by the Director and select one for the scholarship award. All applications must be received by the Director no later than April 19, 2024. Awardees will be notified by mail and/or the Director of Youth Programs.
